Jesus was a King. A King can give you a pardon, or excuse you from paying your taxes. An earthly king has access to alot of money and a good king will see that his people are not hungry or sick.

I wonder how often they gave money to poor people? Answer, often enough that one disciple had a full time job keeping the purse and giving money to the poor.

Matthew 1:1 Matthew starts right out calling Jesus Christ, the Son of David, (the King of the Jews) the son of Abraham.

Matthew 15:22 - 28

Here a woman calls Jesus Son of David and Jesus ignores her. He didn't want to help her until she demonstrated that she knew he was the Son of God. When Jesus realized that she knew He was the Son of David, but also the Son of God, he immediately healed her daughter.

Matthew 16:16 and Luke 9:20

Jesus asks Peter, who do you think I am. Peter answers the Son of God. Matthew 16:19 And Jesus gives Peter the keys to heaven. Matthew 16:20 Then Jesus tells his disciples, don't tell anyone who I am.

Matthew 17:5 and Luke 9: 35 & 36

So Peter and James and John are on the mountain with Jesus. Moses and Elias show up and talk with Jesus. A bright cloud comes up and out of the cloud a voice speaks (God) and says, This is my beloved Son. Hear ye him. Matthew 17:9 Jesus says, don't tell anyone that I am the Son of God until the Son of Man is risen from the dead.

Matthew 17:12 and Luke 9:44 and Luke 18:31 – 33 The Son of Man is going to suffer. This does't say the Son of God will suffer. Somehow Jesus was able to separate himself into, the Son of David, the Son of Man and the Son of God. Matthew 17:22 Says the Son of Man will be betrayed. Not the Son of God.

Matthew 18:11 The Son of man is an evangelist.

Matthew 19:28 Jesus says, if you believe that Jesus the man was rebirthed, then you get a throne. Matthew 20:18 The Son of man will be betrayed. Matthew 20:28 The Son on man came to give his life a ransom for many.

Matthew 20:30 Two blind men call Jesus the Son of David. Matthew 20:32 Jesus says what do you want? Since they called Jesus the King, Jesus wasn't sure what they wanted. Matthew 20:33 They answered Boss, heal our eyes. Matthew 20:34 Jesus had compassion on them, Jesus didn't argue with them about who he was, he simply healed them.

Matthew 21:5 It is Palm Sunday. Jesus calls himself thy King. This is why he could simply take a an ass and her colt. It wasn't steeling. Jesus was the King! Matthew 21:9 And the people blessed him as the Son of David. The King of the Jews. Matthew 21:10 He comes into Jerusalem, this is a different group of people. And they ask who is this. Matthew 21:11 The people answer a prophet. In Jerusalem they were afraid of Cesar. Matthew 21:15 When the priests and the scribes saw the people saying, Hosanna to the Son of David, the priests and scribes were displeased.

Matthew 22:42 This is a really cool verse. Jesus asked the Pharisees, What do you think of Christ? (The anointed one) whose son is he? The Pharisees answered Jesus. The Son of David. (The King of the Jews)

Matthew 24:27 and Luke 17:22 - 24 The Son of man (the human) will come back like lightning. Matthew 24:30 The Son of man (the human) will come in the clouds. Matthew 24:44 Just when you think he is not

coming, the Son of man (the human) will come. Matthew 25:13 You don't know the day nor the hour when the Son of man (the human) will come. Matthew 25:31 When the Son of man (the human) comes with the angels, he will sit on his throne. Matthew 25:34 Then the King,(of the Jews) the Son of David, will say, come and inherit the kingdom. Matthew 25:40 The King, (of the Jews) the Son of David, will say, whatever you have done to the least, you have done to me.

Matt 26:7 – 9 and Luke 7:37

Here a woman has an alabaster box of ointment, She pours this on Jesus head during dinner. But the disciples say she is wasting money. This ointment should have been sold and then they could have given the money to poor people.

Matthew 26:2 and Luke 9:22 and Luke 22:22 the Son of man (the human) will be crucified. Matthew 26:24 The Son of man (the human) will do what has been prophesied of him. But woe to the man who will betray the Son of man (the human). Matthew 26:45 It is time the Son of man (the human) is betrayed. Matthew 26:63 The high priest asked Jesus are you the Son of God? Matthew 26:46 Jesus answered That is what you say. Soon you will see the Son of man (the human) in heaven. Matthew 27:11 and John 18:33 - 38 The governor asked Jesus, are you the King of the Jews? Jesus answered, that is what you say. Matthew 27:29 and John 19:2 They put a crown of thorns on his head and mocked Jesus and said Hail, King of the Jews! (Son of David) Matthew 27:40 They mocked Jesus and said, If you are the Son of God come down from the cross. Matthew 27:43 They mocked him and said, he said I am the Son of God. Matthew 27:54 The soldiers saw the earthquake and said, Truly this was the Son of God. You see you can not kill the Son of God! But you can kill the Son of man (the human) and you can kill the Son of David (the King of the Jews).

Mark starts right out with Jesus Christ, the Son of God.

Mark 1: 11 God claims Jesus as his son. Making him the Son of God.

Mark 1:24 and Luke 4:34 A man with an unclean spirit called out Jesus of Nazareth, I know who you are, the Holy One of God. (Son of God). Mark 1:26 the unclean spirit came out of him. Mark 1:34 Jesus healed many, the devils knew him.

Mark 1:41 and Luke 5:12 - 14 Jesus healed a leper. Mark 1:44 Jesus told the leper don't tell anyone until you have been to see the priest. Mark 1:45 But the leper went out and told everybody.

Mark 2:10 and 5:24 The Son of man (the human) has power to forgive sins. Mark 2:28 and Luke 6:5 The Son of man (the human) is boss of the Sabbath.

Mark 3:11 and Luke 4:41 Unclean spirits call him the Son of God. Mark 3:12 Jesus told the healed people to not tell anyone.

Mark 5:7 and Luke 8:26 - 39 A man with an unclean spirit saw Jesus and yelled, Jesus, the Son of the most high God. Don't torment me. Mark 5:19 After Jesus sent the unclean spirits into the pigs, Jesus told the Gadarenean, go tell your friends.

Mark 5:41 and Luke 8:42 - 56 Jesus brought a dead damsel (Jairus daughter) back to life. Mark 5:43 Jesus told them not to tell anyone.

Mark 7:33 They brought Jesus a deaf man who couldn't speak well. Jesus put his fingers into his ears, and put Jesus spit on his tongue. Mark 7:35 The man was healed. Mark 7:36 And Jesus told them not to tell anyone.

Mark 8:23 Jesus healed a blind man by spiting on his eyes. Mark 8:26 Jesus told him not to tell anyone.

Mark 8:31 Jesus tells the disciples, the Son of man, will be killed, and rise again. Mark 8:38 and Luke 9:26 Jesus says if you are ashamed of me, then the Son of man will be ashamed of you. Mark 9:7 A voice comes out of a cloud and says this is my beloved Son, (Son of God) hear him. Mark 9:9 Jesus told them not to tell anyone about what they saw, until the Son of man was risen from the dead. Mark 9:12 He told them the Son of man will suffer.

Mark 9:27 Jesus healed a boy with a dumb spirit, who foams and gnashes his teeth. Mark 9:30 Jesus didn't want anyone to know it. Mark 9:31 Jesus told his disciples the Son of man will be killed and rise again.

Mark 10:17 and Luke 18:18 – 25 and Matthew 19:16 a guy came to Jesus and called him Good Master, and asked him what to do to inherit eternal life. Mark 10:18 Jesus says Don't call me good, only God is good. Mark 10:22 Jesus told him to give all your money and stuff away. So the guy was sad. Mark 10: 25 Jesus said it is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich man to enter the kingdom of God.

This guy did not recognize Jesus as the Son of God.

Mark 10:45 The Son of man came to give his life for a ransom for many.

Luke 18:35 – 43 and Mark 10:47 – 52 and in Luke 18 – 43

This is the story of blind Bartimaeus that sat by the way side begging. When he heard that Jesus was passing by he yelled, Jesus, thou Son of David, (King of the Jews) have mercy on me. This blind man knew Jesus lineage. He knew he should have been the king if they had not been in captivity.

This beggar could have said to Jesus, they have stolen my lands and my vineyard through emeniate domaine. They are going to make my children and my grandchildren slaves through excessive taxes! And because they have stolen my vineyard they have stolen my livelyhood. And Jesus could have said to Judas (the keeper of the purse) give this man double the money for his estate. And pay his taxes for several years. This is what is meant when the beggar called Jesus Son of David. The people around Jesus told the beggar to be quiet, don't bother him about money now. But Jesus acting as a King said bring him to me. When someone is sick Jesus usually goes to them. But this time this beggar was brought to Jesus, and Jesus said what do you want? And the beggar said Lord (Boss) that I may receive my sight. And Jesus healed him and the beggar gave glory to God! This beggar knew who Jesus was!

Mark 11:10 Blessed be the kingdom of our father David, that cometh in the name of the Lord: Here Jesus is the Son of David (the King of the Jews)

Mark 13:26 and Luke 21:27 The Son of man will come in the clouds. Mark 13:34 and Luke 21:36 Watch for the Son of man. Mark 14:21 Woe to the man who betrays the Son

of man. Mark 14:41 The Son of man is betrayed. Mark 14:61 The high priest asked Jesus Are you the anointed one? Are you the Son of the Blessed? (in Matthew it says Son of God) Mark 14:62 Jesus said, I am and you will see the Son of Man coming in the clouds. Mark 15:2 and Luke 23:3 Pilate asked Jesus, are you the King of the Jews? Jesus said, you said it. Mark 15:9 Pilate wanted to release the King of the Jews. Mark 15:12 Pilate asked the multitude, What do you want me to do with The King of the Jews? Mark 15:18 and Luke 23:37 The soldiers mocked Jesus and called him, King of the Jews. Mark 15:26 and Luke 23:38 and John 19:19 Jesus written accusation said THE KING OF THE JEWS.

Mark 15:39 The soldier said, Truly this man was the Son of God.

Luke 1:32 Jesus shall be called the Son of the Highest and he will be given the throne of David. Luke 1:35 He will be the Son of God. Luke 3:22 A voice came from heaven, it said, Thou art my beloved Son; in thee I am will pleased. (Son of God) Luke 4:3 The devil said to Jesus, if you are the Son of God command this stone to turn into bread. Luke 4:9 The devil said to Jesus, If you are the Son of God, throw yourself down from this pinnacle.

Luke 7:34 The Son of man comes eating and drinking.

Luke 9:56 and Luke 19:10 The Son of man is come to save men's lives.

Luke 12:13 Someone said to Jesus, Master, tell my brother to divide the inheritance with me.

This guy knew Jesus as (the King of the Jews)

Luke 12:14 Jesus said, who made me judge over you?

I wonder what would have happened if that man acknowledge Jesus as the Son of God?

Luke 17:11:18 Ten leapers called, Jesus, Master have mercy on us. Jesus healed them. One of them glorified God. Jesus said where are the other nine? Only one leaper knew that Jesus was the Son of God.

Luke 24:7 Do you remember when he told us the Son of man must be crucified.

John 8:3 - 19

This woman was taken in the act of adultery, she was brought to Jesus by the scribes and Pharisees (attorneys and lawyers). These guys wanted to stone her. And Jesus thought, not while I am King! Jesus bent down and wrote on the ground. Since Jesus was acting as an earthly King in this situation, he wrote on the earth.

I wonder what he wrote? Verse 13 - 19 is the key to this answer. Jesus wrote the lineage of Joseph his adopted father, proving he was heir to the earthly Kingdom. Jesus wrote the lineage of Mary, proving that he was heir to the priesthood. He wrote it, and signed it to make it a legal document. This stated that he was their boss. His position trumped their position. Don't you know who I am! And right now I am acting as her atorney, lawyer. The following argument proves he was arguing over his ancestery. The Pharisees argued with him and said this record of yourself isn't true. And Jesus said, is so! Verse 18 says Jesus defended the point that his Father was our heavenly Father. After mentenally reviewing their own lineage,

the men saw that Jesus could have their jobs and they left, one by one. Verse 11 says neither do I condemn thee: go and sin no more. He only stated who he was. And what authority he had.

Judas was the keeper of the purse and gave money to the poor on a regular basis. When Jesus earthly rein was over, Judas job was terminated and Judas was let go. Oh El Elyon Most High God! Please give me a perminate job. One that will not be terminated very soon.

John 1:12 We have the power to become the Sons of God.

Key: John 2:23 Jesus was in Jerusalem at the Passover Feast. When the people saw the miricles that Jesus did, many believed in his name. John 2:24 But Jesus did not take credit for the miracles. John 2:25 Jesus didn't want anyone to testify of him as a man. (As God yes)

John 2:13 No human man has gone to heaven. But one guy that came down from heaven, the Son of man, he can go to heaven.

John 3:18 If you believe on Jesus, you are not condemned, but if you don't believe you are condemned, because you don't believe the name of Jesus in the name of the only begotten Son of God.

John 4:23 True worshippers worship the Father in spirit and in truth. John 4:26 Jesus said I am the Christ. John 4:29 The woman at the well told everyone that Jesus is the Christ. John 4:42 The people said we know that this is indeed the Christ, the Saviour of the world.

John 5:13 Jesus healed a guy who was laying at pool of Bethesda. But the guy didn't even know it was Jesus that healed him. John 5:14 So Jesus goes and finds this guy in the temple, and tells him to not sin anymore. John 5:15 So this guy goes and tells the Jews that it was Jesus who healed him. John 5:16 So the Jews wanted to kill Jesus because he healed on the wrong day.

John 5:27 God gave Jesus authority because he is the Son of man. (human)

John 6:53 Communion, you eat the flesh and drink the blood of the Son of man. (human)

John 9:35 Here is a guy who was born blind, Jesus made clay and rubbed it into his eyes and told him to go and wash. And the guy was healed. So the guy who was blind gets cast out of the synagogue, because Jesus did it on the wrong day. John 9:37 So Jesus finds him and tells him that he is the Son of God.

John 11:4 Jesus let Lazarus die so that the Son of God would be glorified. (thought about) John 11:27 Martha said to Jesus, I believe thou art the Christ, the Son of God. John 11:26 Jesus made Martha say it.

John 14:14 The name Jesus includes, Christ, the Son of God, the Son of David and the Son of man. John 20:21 Believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and you will get life through his name.

Jesus the Son of man (the human) doesn't heal, Jesus the Son of David (the King of the Jews) doesn't heal, at least if he does he doesn't take credit for it. Jesus the Son of God heals and likes it to be told.
