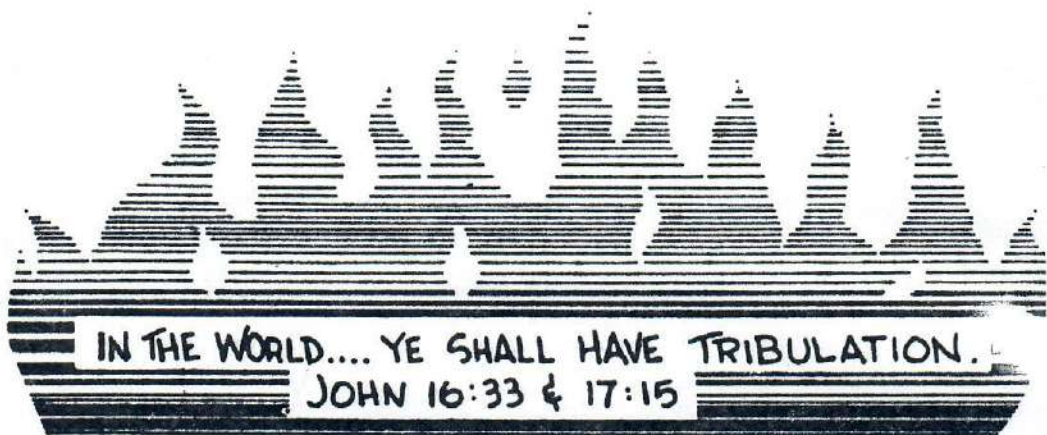

DELIVERANCE THROUGH TRIBULATION

What the Word of God says and what man thinks it says aren't necessarily the same, and sometimes heaven and hell can hang on the difference.

This is the case concerning the interpretation of the Scriptures often quoted to support the false belief and teaching of the rapture as opposed to the multitude of verses and illustrations pointing out how God will protect you as you pass through the tribulation.

One such example of how you can depend on God's wonderful protection is found in the 91st Psalm. In it David sings:

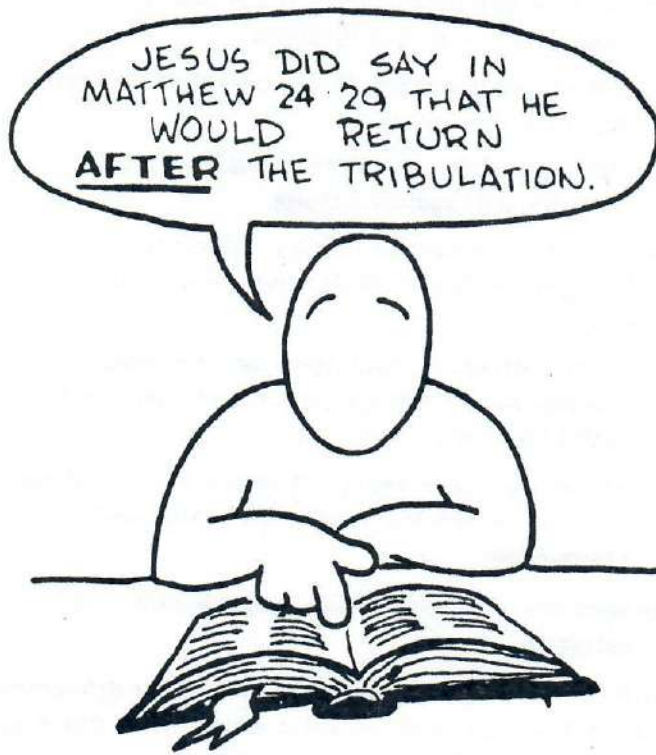
He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most
High shall abide under the shadow of the
Almighty.

I will say of the Lord, He is my refuge and my
fortress: my God; in Him will I trust.

Surely he shall deliver thee from the snare of the
fowler, and from the noisome pestilence.

He shall cover thee with his feathers, and under
his wings shalt thou trust: his truth shall be
thy shield and buckler.

Thou shalt not be afraid for the terror by night;
nor for the arrow that flieth by day;

Nor for the pestilence that walketh in darkness; nor

A thousand shall fall at thy side, and ten thousand

Because thou hast made the Lord, which is my
refuge, even the most High, thy habitation;

There shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any

They shall bear thee up in their hands, lest thou
dash thy foot against a stone.

Thou shalt tread upon the lion and adder: the young
lion and the dragon shalt thou trample under
feet.

Because he hath set his love upon me, therefore will
I deliver him: I will set him on high, because he
hath known my name.

He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I will be
with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and
honour him.

With long life will I satisfy him, and shew him my
salvation.

This Psalm is proof we can trust in God for deliverance
through any tribulation. Another verse which offers this proof
is Isaiah 43.2. It says: "When thou passest through the waters,
I will be with thee, and through the rivers, they shall not
overflow thee; when thou walkest through the fire, thou
shalt not be burned; neither shall the flame kindle upon
thee."

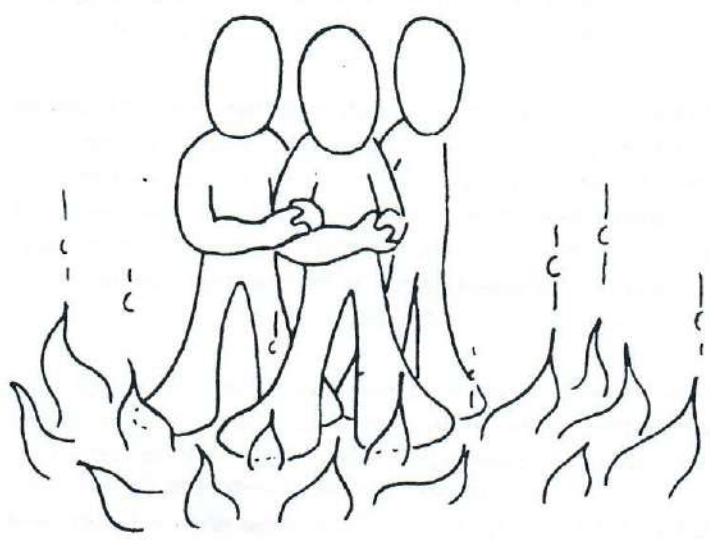
NOT BURNED BY FIRE

An illustration of passing through the fire without being burned is found in Daniel 3:19-29:

"Then was Nebuchadnezzar full of fury, and the form of his visage was changed against Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego: therefore he spake, and commanded that they should heat the furnace one seven times more than it was wont to be heated. And he commanded the most mighty men that were in his army to bind Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, and to cast them into the burning fiery furnace. Then these men were bound in their coats, their hosen, and their hats, and their other garments, and were cast into the midst of the burning fiery furnace. Therefore because the king's commandment was urgent, and the furnace exceeding hot, the flame of the fire slew those men that took up Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego. And these three men, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, fell down bound into the midst of the burning fiery furnace. Then Nebuchadnezzar the king was astonished, and rose up in haste, and spake, and said unto his counsellors, Did not we cast three men bound into the midst of the fire? They answered and said unto the king, True, O king. He answered and said, Lo, I see four men loose, walking in the midst of the fire, and they have no hurt; and the form of the fourth is like the Son of God.

"Then Nebuchadnezzar came near to the mouth of the burning fiery furnace, and spake, and said, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, ye servants of the most high God, come forth, and come hither. Then Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, came forth of the midst of the fire. And the princes, governors, and captains, and the king's counsellors, being gathered together, saw these men, upon whose bodies the fire had no power, nor was an hair of their head singed, neither were their coats changed, nor the smell of fire had passed on them. Then Nebuchadnezzar spake, and said, Blessed be the God of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego,

who hath sent his angel, and delivered his servants that trusted in him, and have changed the king's word, and yielded their bodies, that they might not serve nor worship any god, except their own God. Therefore I make a decree, That every people, nation, and language, which speak any thing amiss against the God of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, shall be cut in pieces, and their houses shall be made a dunghill: because there is no other God that can deliver after this sort."

NOT HURT BY LIONS

Daniel 6:16-23 also contains an illustration of being delivered through the tribulation and not lifted out of a situation which seemingly - in the natural - can only end in death:

"Then the king commanded, and they brought Daniel, and cast him into the den of lions. Now the king spake and said unto Daniel, Thy God, whom thou servest continually, he will deliver thee. And a stone was brought and laid upon the mouth of the den; and the king sealed it with his own signet, and with the signet of his lords; that the purpose might not be changed concerning Daniel.

"Then the king went to his palace, and passed the night fasting: neither were instruments of music brought before him: and his sleep went from him. Then the king arose very early in the morning, and went in haste unto the den of lions. And when he came to the den, he cried with a lamentable voice unto Daniel: and the king spake and said to Daniel, O Daniel, servant of the living God, is thy God, whom thou servest continually, able to deliver thee from the lions? Then said Daniel unto the king, O King, live for ever. My God hath sent his angel, and hath shut the lions' mouths, that they have not hurt me: forasmuch as before him innocency was found in me: and also before thee, O king, have I done no hurt. Then was the king exceeding glad for him, and commanded that they should take Daniel up out of the den. So Daniel was taken up out of the den, and no manner of hurt was found upon him, because he believed in his God."

These are examples of the supernatural delivering power of God. There is a natural and also a supernatural power, and God provides the supernatural deliverance from temptation, from trial and from tribulation. Learn these scriptures of deliverance because there is an excellent and wonderful possibility you can be a part of that final gener-

ation that overcomes the last enemy, which is death.

Impossible? Not at all. According to the Scriptures, the generation that is alive and remaining at the opening of the sixth seal (Rev. 6:12) will be the generation that shall hear the blowing of the last (1 Cor. 15:52) trumpet (Matt. 24:39-35). (See the booklet - Key to Revelation - by this author, for a complete explanation of the sixth seal.) But you must keep your eyes on Jesus and be ready to follow his commands.

WALKED ON WATER

This is illustrated in the story of Peter, when he looked out of the boat on the Sea of Galilee and saw Jesus walking on the water. Peter said, "Lord, if it is you, bid me come." Jesus answered, "Come," and Peter walked on top of the water. As he did, God supernaturally gave him power enabling him to rise above the problem, above the trouble, above the situation of life. With his eyes upon the Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, Peter had the supernatural power to walk on top of the water. But there is something else to learn from the lesson, too. When Peter took his eyes off Jesus, he started to sink. When you remove your eyes from the Lord and look down at the trouble, the problem, the temptation or the tribulation, you begin to sink. That's when you begin to fall under the natural power of this world. But as long as you have that supernatural power which comes from having your eyes on your Lord Jesus, you can perform supernatural actions — even walking on the water.

THROUGH, NOT OUT

As you study these Scriptures, you learn that God takes His people "through" the trouble, not out of it. There is no need to worry about any tribulation because you are in His hands, and they're big and strong enough to protect you. As with Noah, you will receive supernatural instructions to protect and carry you through any problems so that you won't have to be lifted out, or removed, from them.

The most commonly used Scripture for teaching that people will be lifted out in the rapture is Matthew 24: 40-41: "Then shall two be in the field; the one shall be taken, and the other left. Two women shall be grinding at the mill; the one shall be taken, and the other left."

Sometimes this is interpreted: "Two shall be in the field. The GOOD ONE shall be RAPTURED and the BAD ONE, LEFT."

That is not what that passage says. It does not designate whether the good one or the bad one shall be taken – and it does not mention rapture. It just says one will be taken and the other left. But in our fundamental desire to find some way out of the bad things that are going to happen during the tribulation we read into the passage something which is not there. I used to say this refers to the rapture when I was studying the normal, fundamental way of interpreting this Scripture. I used to say the Christian would be raptured and the other left. But let's ask Jesus if it is the good or bad one who is to be taken first. Jesus answers the question in Matthew 13: 37-39, where He says: "He that soweth the good seed is the Son of man; The field is the world; the good seed are the children of the kingdom; but the tares are the children of the wicked one; The enemy that sowed them is the devil; the harvest is the end of the world; and the reapers are the angels."

Using the interpretation Jesus gave the parable, in

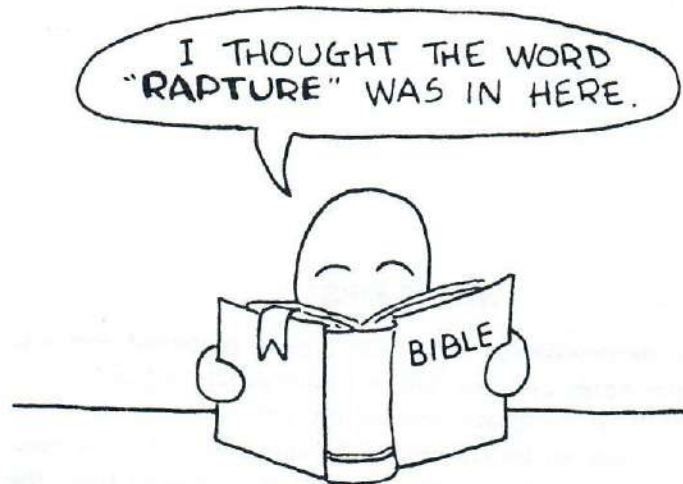
Matthew 13:24, you discover the kingdom of heaven is likened to when Jesus Christ sowed seed; because in Matthew 13:37 you read he that sowed the good seed is the Son of man. The good seed are the Christians, or the children of the kingdom, and the field is the world. So the kingdom of heaven is likened unto when Jesus sowed the Christians in the world. Matthew 13:25 says while men slept his enemy came and sowed tares among the wheat and went his way. In other words, the devil came, sowed his disciples (the bad people) among the good people (the Christians) and went his way. Verse 26 says when the blade was sprung up and brought forth fruit the tares also appeared. Thus, in our Christian society, we have Christians, and alongside them, non-Christians acting as if they are real Christians. But they are not. In verse 27, the servants of the householder (the angels) came and said unto him, "Sir, didst not thou sow good seed in thy field? (Didn't you put the good Christians into the world?) "From whence then hath it tares?" (bad ones.)

He answered, in verse 28, that an enemy (the devil) had done this.

The servants (the angels) said to him, "Wilt thou then that we go and gather the bad ones up?"

But He said unto them, "Nay, lest while ye gather the tares or the bad ones ye also root up the wheat, the good ones, or the children of the kingdom, with them. Let them grow together until the harvest. Then, in the time of the harvest, I will say to the reapers (the angels), 'Gather ye together FIRST the tares and bind them in bundles to burn them, but gather the wheat into my barn'."

NOTICE! First the tares. Jesus settles the matter in Matthew 13. He says first the bad ones, then the good ones. Jesus said first the tares, which are the children of the devil or the wicked one, are separated, then the remaining ones are to be gathered together into the supernatural protection of his barn.

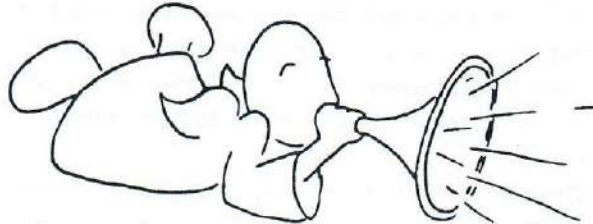
You may have seen tracts which say the opposite of what Jesus said by using Scriptures such as Matthew 24 - which say two shall be in the field and one shall be taken and the other left - to teach there will be a rapture of the church first. The tracts show pictures of an airplane in a dive because the pilot had been raptured and all the people left were screaming, or a bus about to go over a cliff because the driver, who was a Christian, was being raptured. You probably have seen all these things which say, first Christians are taken and bad persons remain to inherit the world. But that is not what Jesus said in Matthew 24. It does not say Christians will be taken out first. People have read into that Scripture what they want it to say. They would call this the rapture. Of course, the word "rapture" isn't even in the Bible. That has been made up, too.

WHO IS FIRST?

The denomination to which I once belonged and also the margin notes of some Bibles I have purchased say that in the last time, at the appearance of the antichrist, the Christian does not need to be concerned because he will have been raptured. We were taught that we will be removed from the world before the appearance of the antichrist, before the antichrist is manifested. We were taught to keep looking for Jesus, because His return will be first. Then, according to that old teaching, after the return of Jesus and after the rapture, the antichrist will come and take over. But that is not what the Bible says, even if it is what I was taught and what I used to teach. For many years I taught that first it would be the rapture, then after that, the antichrist. Now I see the truth of the matter, as shown in II Thessalonians 2:1-3, "Now we beseech you, brethern, by the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, and by our gathering together unto him. That ye be not soon shaken in mind, or be troubled, neither by spirit, nor by word, nor by letter as from us, as that the day of Christ is at hand. Let no man deceive you by any means: for that day shall not come, except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition."

This teaches in very clear, concise words that the man of sin, the son of perdition, will be revealed first. After that we will be gathered together unto Him. Of course, in connection with the revelation of the man of sin, there shall be the great apostasy, or falling away, reported in the third verse.

THE RESURRECTION

Now, so there is no misunderstanding, examine I Thessalonians 4:13-18. First, however, I want to stress I believe in the resurrection. The Bible is completely convincing there will be a resurrection. But many people who are alive and remain and grasp the truth of these studies will not have to go through death. You will be alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord. You will be the generation that overcomes death. Now, turning to Thessalonians: "But I would not have you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning them which are asleep, that ye sorrow not, even as others which have no hope. For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him. For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep. For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord. Wherefore comfort one another with these words."

TRUMP OF GOD

Notice this passage mentions the trump of God. Revelation teaches there are seven trumpets to be sounded. This verse indicates Jesus will descend with the sound of a trump, indicating about the time He should come. In other words, one of the seven trumps will signal the return of our Lord Jesus Christ. If you study a little further you will discover which trump.

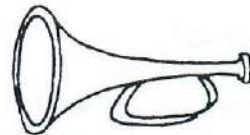
I Corinthians 15:51-52 says: "Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed."

This is in accord with the reference to the trump in Thessalonians. Revelation 10:7 also sets the record straight by referring to the seventh (last) trump, saying: "But in the days of the voice of the seventh angel, when he shall begin to sound, the mystery of God should be finished, as he hath declared to his servants the prophets."

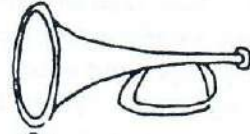
At the sound of the seventh - or last - trump, this prophecy that has been the groaning of the ages will be finished. Revelation ties in with I Thessalonians 4:16 and I Corinthians 15:52, with all agreeing that the return of the Lord is in connection with the sound of the last (seventh) trumpet. Three witnesses speak of the same thing. Read it carefully and you will find it has to be at the last trump. The return of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ is at the last trump. It is true that I Corinthians was written by Paul before Revelation was written by John, and someone might ask, "How then could the last trump (I Cor.) refer to the seventh trump (Rev.), because Revelation was written later?"

God often reveals truth to his prophets who write as the Holy Spirit leads them, and later the Holy Spirit will lead another prophet to write further information concerning the same subject. An example is in Daniel 9:2, wherein Daniel understood and added further information to a prophecy given by Jeremiah many years before.

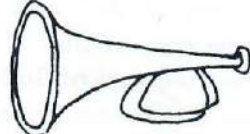
THE RETURN OF OUR LORD AND SAVIOR JESUS CHRIST IS AT THE BLOWING OF THE LAST TRUMP.



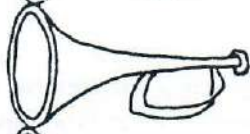

BODY OF CHRIST

You have seen that the Bible says the antichrist shall appear on earth before the Christ. There is an antichrist body and also a Body of Christ forming in the world right now. The Holy Spirit being imparted and implanted in us makes us part of this Body of Christ. The Bible asks, "What, know ye not that ye are the temple of the Holy Spirit? And as many as are led of the Spirit, they are the sons of God. And to as many as are led of the Spirit, they are the sons of God. And to as many as believed on him to them gave He power to become sons of God."

This - becoming sons of God - is a progressive act. The fact you have not reached the limit of what God has for you is not a consequential matter because you "are becoming" on a daily basis. If you will look for the change in your life and expect God to change you and cause you to conform to His own image, to put on the mind of Christ, you will be "becoming" a member of the Body of Christ. But there is another group which will not accept what Jesus says. This group is formed of people who will do what Satan says. These people are headed for the lake of fire. In a short time, Jesus Christ will come and take the body of the antichrist and deposit it in that lake of fire that burns to the end of the age. But Jesus promises members of the Body of Christ who will follow Him wherever He goes and do whatever He commands that they will sit with Him in His throne, "Even as I am set down with my Father in His throne." Jesus promises thrones for the overcomers and fire for those who will not do His will.

BECOME PERFECT

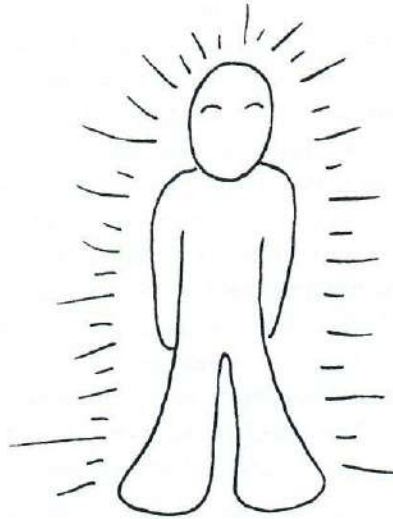
You who have this "hope of His coming" and believe you will be alive and remain until the coming of the Lord, will be able to look in I John 3:3 and understand: "Every man that hath this 'hope' in him purifieth himself even as He is pure."

This purifying process is taking place in you because the hope of His coming is making you put on the mind of Christ, making you conform to His own image, and you are getting better instead of worse.

The last generation, the generation that is alive and remains to the coming of the Lord, will be a perfect generation. These people will have achieved a realm of perfection spoken of in the Bible. They will have put on the mind of Christ; they will have conformed to His own image. Those who have died cannot be made perfect until you, the last and final generation, have entered into that perfection. Hebrews 11:40 - a wonderful chapter of the champions of faith - says: "God having provided some better thing for us, that they without us should not be made perfect." Jesus, talking about His return to earth, said He was coming for a glorious church without spot or wrinkle. Notice, He said this church He is coming for is without spot or wrinkle. If you can find one church anywhere in the world that is without spot or wrinkle right now, I would like to know about it. The truth is, God is changing men and is bringing them into perfection. We have removed the spots on our dirty garments with the blood of Jesus Christ, the Lord and Saviour. God also is presently removing the wrinkles from His church. He said "without spot or wrinkle", and the pressures and heat of daily life are removing the wrinkles like a hot, heavy iron moving over a garment. That is the reason for the trouble you are in today. (Eph. 5:27).

James 1:2-4 says: "My brethren, count it all joy when ye fall into diverse temptations; Knowing this, that the trying of your faith worketh patience. But let patience have her perfect work, that ye may be perfect and entire, wanting nothing."

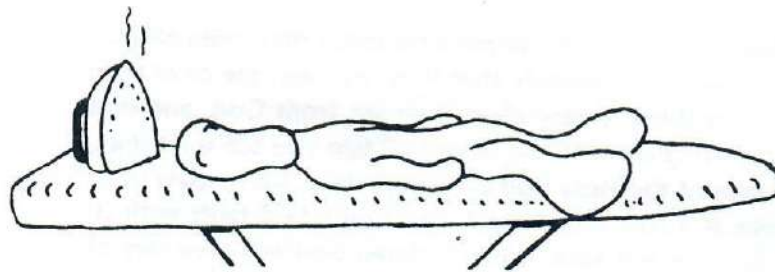
Therefore, this "ironing" is a time of trying, of temptations, of testing your faith. Jesus is putting the iron, the pressure on you to remove the wrinkles. He is going to have a perfect church without spot, without wrinkle. The trouble today is - the church is not ready for the return of Christ because it is full of spots and wrinkles. But the good thing is - Jesus is working on you, changing you, making you without spot and without wrinkle, and you'll be like Him for you'll see Him as He is. You must have this hope within you; you must believe what is in I John 3:2-3: "Beloved, now we are the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is. And every man that hath this hope in him purifieth himself, even as he is pure."

You are the sons of God because the Holy Spirit is leading you, and as many as believed on Him to them gave

He power to become the sons of God. But look at verse 3 again: "Every man that hath this hope in him purifieth himself." This is a continual action; this is a constant move. It means right now you are purifying yourselves. Why? Because you have the hope of His appearing. You know when He appears you shall be like Him for you shall see Him as He is. The only way to be like Him is to have a perfect robe without spot, without wrinkle. It is possible to move in the realm of learning to become perfect. God is going to come for a perfect church. Get this into your minds and start counting these blessings. Count it an honor when you have problems and temptations, knowing it is an "ironing out" process for your perfection. The good thing about it is that God does care. He does love you. In spite of the pressures of today, the problems you are going through, there is plenty of proof God loves you. After you have been through these trials, you will have learned the lessons and furthered your process of perfection. Then you will act like a son of God, talk like a son of God, and think like a son of God. By that time you will be manifested as a son of God and the whole world groaneth for this manifestation. If any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of His (Romans 8:9). Continuing in Romans 8:10-19, it says: "And if Christ be in you, the body is dead because of sin; but the Spirit is life because of righteousness. But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you. Therefore, brethren, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live after the flesh. For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live. For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God. For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father. The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God: And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that

we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together. For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us. For the earnest expectation of the creature waiteth for the manifestation of the sons of God."

THE HOLY SPIRIT

ANTICHRIST FIRST

There is in the world today a group of people being formed into the Body of Christ. But also remember the other group is gathering together to become manifest as the anti-christ body. And notice in II Thessalonians, the antichrist gets the jump. This group is manifested first, followed by the Christ body. So, as you read your newspapers, or watch television and see these things approaching, don't be afraid. It is only the proof that God is in charge, that these things are working out exactly as He said. But this antichrist group will have no power over you because you have Jesus Christ, the true Christ, and also you have the anointing, the Holy Spirit. You are led of the Spirit and are in His body. In these last days, God is pouring His Spirit upon all flesh.

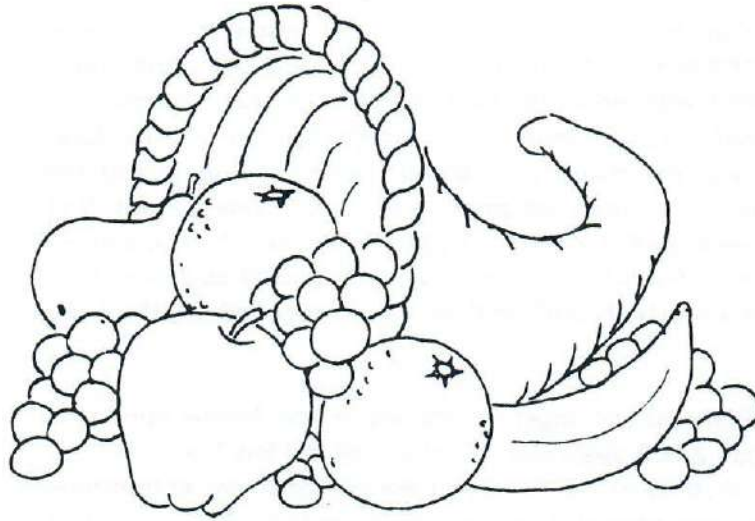
CHANGE

In line with this, I Corinthians 12:8 tells you: "For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit." In many assemblies today, the word of wisdom, or the word of knowledge, which is supernatural knowledge, is in operation. Continuing in I Corinthians 12:9-11: "To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit; to another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another diverse kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues: But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as he will."

There is a group of people who teach that these gifts of the Holy Spirit are devilish, that they are from the devil himself. Yet the Bible is very clear they are from God, and that God is restoring them to the church. When you see something in the realm of the Holy Spirit, investigate it, participate in it, and make it a part of yourself. But don't find fault with it. And if you are not sure, leave it alone. God will take care of it if it is not His will. But know that it is His will, because we are in the last days, and He is restoring these gifts to the church. Although the church hasn't had all these things in operation for about 1,650 years, that doesn't make it wrong for God to turn around and restore them. He promised that in the last days He would restore to His church the things it formerly had.

GOD WILL RESTORE

Joel 2:23: "Be glad then, ye children of Zion, and rejoice in the Lord your God: for he hath given you the former rain moderately, and he will cause to come down for you the rain, the former rain, and the latter rain in the first month.



FOR SUCH AS BE BLESSED OF HIM SHALL INHERIT
THE EARTH ; AND THEY THAT BE CURSED OF HIM
SHALL BE CUT OFF.
Psalm 37:22

And the floors shall be full of wheat, and the vats shall overflow with wine and oil. And I will restore to you the years that the locust hath eaten, the cankerworm, and the caterpillar, and the palmerworm, my great army which I sent among you. And ye shall eat in plenty, and be satisfied, and praise the name of the Lord your God, that hath dealt wondrously with you: and my people shall never be ashamed. And ye shall know that I am in the midst of Israel, and that I am the Lord your God, and none else: and my people shall never be ashamed.

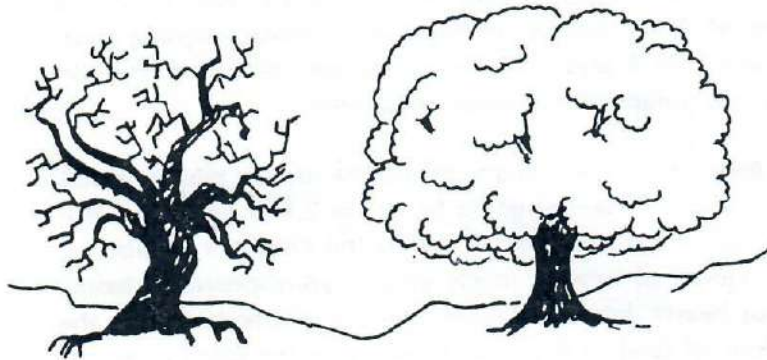
"And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young

men shall see visions: And also upon the servants and upon the handmaids in those days will I pour out my spirit. And I will shew wonders in the heavens and in the earth, blood, and fire, and pillars of smoke. The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before the great and the terrible day of the Lord come. And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be delivered: for in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem shall be deliverance, as the Lord hath said, and in the remnant whom the Lord shall call."

Joel tied this together. He said in the former rain - that is about 2,000 years ago - God poured out His Spirit upon all flesh. A study of the history of the church shows at that time it was very powerful and giving off its light. But it was like those olive trees that were covered with greenery. He said He allowed the locust, the cankerworm, the caterpillar and the palmerworm to come and eat off this tree, and in the Book of Revelation you find the tree fell over and died and laid on the street. The thing that killed the tree - killed the church - was the fact that Theodosius in 380 AD proclaimed that all the people were Christians. That killed the church. You don't turn people into Christians just by hanging that name on them. Theodosius tried, and he made the people think they were Christians, and they really weren't. You can't be born into Christianity. You must come into it yourself. God has no grandsons. You, yourself, must establish a son relationship with God. But Theodosius said the people were Christians by virtue of the fact that he was the Emperor of the world and because he called them that, and he killed the move of the Holy Spirit. They had no further need of the Holy Spirit. But God said, "Although I poured My former rain out moderately, I will pour the latter rain in great abundance."

Peter, in Acts 2:16, quoted from this prophecy in verse 28, saying, "But this is that which was spoken by the prophet

Joel." Peter was speaking of the pouring out of the Holy Spirit. Reading from the same prophecy, in Joel 2:31, note, the sun shall be turned into darkness and the moon into blood before that great and terrible day of the Lord will come. This refers to the opening of the sixth seal of Revelation, (Rev. 6:12) when the sun and moon will be affected. While God is preparing for the opening of the sixth seal, He also is presently pouring out His Spirit in the day of this restoration, in the time of the fifth seal. God's pouring out of His Spirit is the restoration spoken of in Joel 2:25, which says, "I will restore to you the years that the locust hath eaten, the cankerworm, and the caterpillar, and the palmerworm." God is restoring, and at this moment, the church is starting to stand to its feet. The Body of Christ is beginning to be restored by the supernatural power of the Holy Spirit.

HEAVEN OR EARTH ?

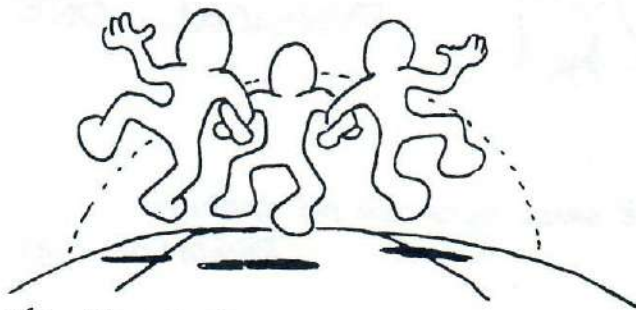
Matthew 5:5 says: "Blessed are the meek: for they shall inherit the earth." Jesus says the meek shall inherit the EARTH. Some people are expecting the meek to inherit heaven, but Jesus said the meek shall inherit the earth. Along the same line, Revelation 5:8-10 says: "And when he had taken the book, the four beasts and four and twenty elders fell down before the Lamb, having every one of them harps, and golden vials full of odours, which are the prayers of saints. And they sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for thou wast slain, and hast redeemed us to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation; And hast made us unto our God kings and priests: and we shall reign on the earth."

This passage doesn't say you shall reign in heaven. It says you shall reign on earth. Jesus said in Revelation 3:21: "To him that overcometh will I grant to sit with me in my throne, even as I also overcame and am set down with my Father in his throne." You who overcome will sit in the throne of Jesus and be members of a ruling, reigning class. Revelation 20:4 says: "And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them."

Jesus Christ is coming to set up the earthly kingdom that people thought He was going to set up 2,000 years ago. But 2,000 years ago He came to set up the kingdom of God, or the kingdom of heaven, inside you, in your innermost being, in your hearts, because people were not ready to receive the kingdom of God in the natural realm on the earth or in the world. But because the kingdom of God is within you and is changing you, making you what you ought to be, soon there will be people who will move on into perfection and who will become the manifested sons of God. They will overcome in every area; they will sit on thrones; they will rule and reign with Jesus Christ on this earth for 1 000 years.

CONTINUE TO CHANGE

The wonderful fact is that He is changing you. You are not the same as you were yesterday. Today you're different. You are seeing new things in the Scriptures; you are moving on in the Spirit. You are not camping somewhere, staying at some old truth revealed 50, 60, 100, or even 10 years ago. You are constantly in the Word; constantly in prayer and fasting and asking God to change and make you what you ought to be. Don't expect everyone to have arrived at this degree of perfection. But everyone who has been called according to God, from before the foundation of the world, is moving on and is being changed. It is just like a school-room: Some are in the first grade, some in the fourth and some in the 12th. You are moving on, being changed, seeing new truths. You are being moved upon by the Holy Spirit, and the Holy Spirit is taking control of various phases of your lives. If you have felt this tug in your heart, if you have felt the move of the spirit to change your mind about various things, then begin to investigate. Always remember, everything good that happens is based upon the Word of God, and God's Word is pure and true and will not change. But churches teach both the Word of God and tradition, and the two don't always agree; they aren't necessarily the same. Therefore, be very careful to analyze and be certain your belief is based on the Word of God and not on church or denominational traditions.



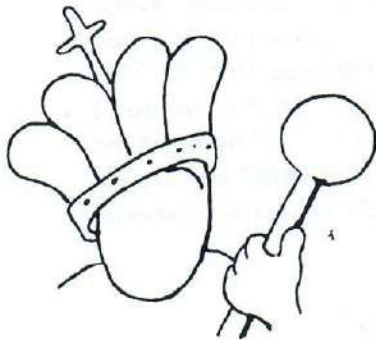

There are thousands of people who think the "RAPTURE" idea-with driver-less cars and crashing airplanes-is nothing but an emotion packed made up story with no Bible basis. But all Christians agree there will be a "RESURRECTION" in the future. The sensational display of the terror filled tribulation really has nothing to do with when the "RESURRECTION" will take place. We are convinced the Bible teaches the "RESUR-

RECTION" will take place at the end of the tribulation, not before it.



DID JESUS SAY THE CHURCH WILL BE RAPTURED BEFORE THE TRIBULATION?

HE DID NOT !!!

He said, "I pray not that thou shouldst take them out of the world, but that thou should keep them from the evil." (John 17:15)

CHANGE YOUR MIND

Thousands of Christians are changing their minds about the "rapture" of the church. We used to think the "rapture" would take place before the tribulation. Now, we see the Bible shows the resurrection will be at the end of the time of trouble.



But not everyone agrees. Some denominations still hold strongly to their traditions about the "rapture" in spite of all the Bible evidence to show it will be at the end of the tribulation. Some people know more about prophecy from listening to a quartet sing "I'LL FLY AWAY" than from Bible study, but things are changing. I found there are many Bible students who believe the resurrection will take place at the end of the tribulation. But I

was shocked to find that a few people actually count us as their enemy after we changed to believe the Bible, not their tradition.

After many years I discovered that nearly all Bible students believe the "rapture" takes place after the tribulation and that some people mistakenly believe it takes place before. Then I discovered that people hate each other and fight each other because of their disagreement about the "rapture." Brothers, this should not be!



The most shocking thing this study has shown me is that Christianity is presently divided over issues which are important but not important enough to make Christians hate each other. Now I have seen that everyone in my city who names the name of Jesus Christ is my brother and is in the "real Church" no matter what he believes about the rapture.

However, I have now seen that denominationalism is a great enemy to the cause of Christ. People who think their own denomination is "the greatest" are badly deceived and they do much to hurt real Christianity.

To be real Christians we must get our eyes off our rules of discipline and doctrinal statements and put our eyes on Jesus Christ. Jesus told us the way to know if a person is a Christian and a brother, is by our love toward each other. When

you see "Christians" hating each other and hurting each other then you know they are very immature, like children.

The other two things which are enemies to the cause of Christ are the traditions and commandments of the Church. People mistakenly think that what the "church" said is what Jesus said—but there is a big difference. I did not know this until I started to study the "rapture question," and now I see it applies to a whole lot more beside rapture.

There will not be a **RAPTURE** before the tribulation; the **RESURRECTION** will be at the end of the trouble. Let us get this straight: There is no scripture anywhere that proves the rapture is first. The notes in the Scofield Bible are the biggest offender and have done the most to project the error. I changed my mind, after Bible study (not Scofield note study), and began to teach Christians to get ready for trouble. God never promised to send Christians his wrath (wrath is for the unbeliever) but He did promise to send us tribulation.

Some of our friends did not like the idea of going through the tribulation, so they began to wonder if we who believe in a post-tribulation resurrection were really saved. Now look; salvation does not depend on what you believe regarding the rapture or tribulation. Salvation has to do with believing on Jesus Christ and following Him, and I am saved in spirit, I am

being saved in soul and by the grace of God I will be saved in body, all through Jesus Christ! Furthermore, this does not question your salvation, either.



IN THE WORLD YE SHALL HAVE TRIBULATION... JOHN 16:33.

One denomination will not extend the right hand of fellowship to you unless you agree with them in their mistaken idea about the rapture. Now I see that many Christians really believe their leaders are infallible and their denominations can't make a mistake.

SALVATION COMES BY FAITH IN JESUS CHRIST NOT FAITH IN A PRE, MID, POST OR PAN TRIB' RAPTURE THEORY.



Some evangelicals hand out a newspaper type tract showing shocking pictures of horror and havoc after a supposed rapture, but the paper is repulsive to Bible students because no scriptures are given to prove the ideas. Some people who had dreams or visions of the rapture were so completely disarmed by the barrage of scriptures showing the errors of the newspaper tracts and their visions that they retaliated with rage. This shows me that present Christianity must go through more changing and come into love, not hate.

We have to come to the idea that everyone who names the name of Jesus Christ is a Christian, no matter what they believe concerning the rapture. We have let our different denominational leaders brainwash us into thinking that unless everyone agrees with our group, they are in danger. Really, the person who is in danger is the one who thinks he is right and has not changed much lately.

A great churchman, Dr. **OSWALD J. SMITH** (TORONTO), said, "Now, after years of study and prayer I am absolutely convinced that there will be no rapture before the tribulation, but that the Church will undoubtedly be called upon to face the Antichrist, and that Christ will come at the close of, not at the beginning of, that awful period." He said, "I have always held (in the past) the view that the Rapture precedes the Revelation by some seven years." Something changed the mind of that great Bible student and preacher.

He went on to say, "I believed the other theory simply because I was taught it by W.E. Blackstone in his book 'Jesus is Coming,' the Scofield reference Bible and Prophetic Conferences and Bible Schools; but when I began to search for the scriptures for myself I discovered that there is not a single verse in the Bible that upholds the pre-tribulation theory, but that the uniform teaching of the Word of God is a post-tribulation rapture." Search the scriptures for yourself and your mind also will be changed.

AFTER THE TRIBULATION

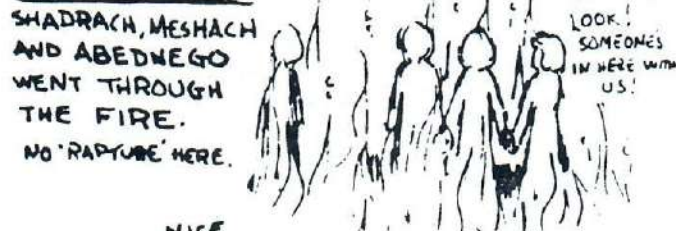
Jesus placed the sign of His second coming "immediately **AFTER** the tribulation of those days." (Matt. 24:29) The Bible **DOES NOT** say the Christians will be raptured **FIRST** when two are in the field, one taken and one left. (Matt. 24:40-41) However, it is clear that the children of the wicked are taken **FIRST** from reading **MATTHEW 13:24-43**.

SUPERNATURAL PROTECTION

Noah was not raptured out of the flood water; he went through the water. God said, "When thou passest through the waters, I will be with thee; and through the rivers, they shall not overflow thee: when thou walkest through the fire, thou shalt not be burned; neither shall the flame kindle upon thee." (Isaiah 43:2) Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego saw the fourth man and went through the fire. They were not raptured out. Daniel was not raptured out of the Lion's den; he went through it.

God has established a pattern of providing supernatural protection for His people so

they have had the power to go through the test, not out of it. Why would He change His pattern for the last great Tribulation? -



GOD HAS ESTABLISHED A PATTERN..

God said, "Only with thine eyes shalt thou behold and see the reward of the wicked. There shall no evil befall thee." (Psalm 91) A mighty supernatural deliverance was wrought by God by protecting all His children in Egypt.

THROUGH, NOT OUT

They went through the last SEVEN plagues but Israel did not suffer from them. (Exodus 8:22-23, 9:4)

When we study how God poured out his wrath in Egypt during the **LAST SEVEN** plagues we notice an amazing parallel to when God will pour out his wrath during the **LAST SEVEN** vials of wrath (also seven trumpets) of the book of Revelation.

Just as God protected His people from His wrath in Egypt. He will also protect His people from His wrath in the end time. But it should be noted, his people always go through it, not out of it.

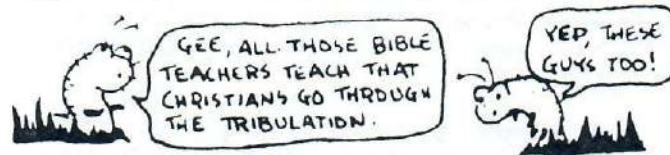
FAMOUS CHURCHMEN AGREE

Dr. Henry W. Frost, former Home Director of CHINA INLAND MISSION, wrote a book "MATTHEW 24 AND THE REVELATION." In it he argues conclusively for a **POST**-tribulation rapture.

A man from England, Edmund Shackleton, wrote a book, "WILL THE CHURCH ESCAPE THE GREAT TRIBULATION? Anyone who reads either book will be convinced that there will be no rapture before the tribulation.

Rev. Pat Robertson, a famous radio and TV personality, has spent many hours on his own stations telling his audience they would go through the tribulation, not out of it.

Here is a list of Bible teachers who have written to show that we will go through the tribulation: David Baron, Dr. Bergin, Dr. Horatius Bonar, Charles T. Cook, Charles R. Erdman, W. J. Erdman, Bishop Frank Houghton, Dr. Campbell Morgan, Dr. Adolph Saphir, Dr. A. B. Simpson, H. W. Soltan, Dr. J. W. Thistle, Henry Varley, Nathaniel West, Lennard Darby, Norman S. Mac Pherson.



Other famous men who have taken this position are George Muller, John B. Scruby, Norman Douty and George Ladd (Fuller Theological Seminary), J. Barton Payne ... (Wheaton College).

HISTORY OF THE RAPTURE THEORY (FALSE)

Mr. Edmund Shakleton opened his book with the statement, "All who held the pre-millennial Coming of Christ were... of one mind on the subject... (until circa 1830) About that time a new view was promulgated that the Coming of Christ ~~was~~ not one event, but that it was divided into stages, in fact, that Christ comes twice from Heaven to earth, but the first time only as far as the air. The first descent, it is said, will be for the purpose of removing the Church from the world, and will occur before the Great Tribulation under Anti-christ... This they call "The coming for His Saints" or "Secret Rapture." The second part of the Coming is said to take place when Christ appears in glory and destroys the Anti-christ. This they call, "The coming with His saints."

Mr. H. A. Baker wrote, "For eighteen centuries the fundamental principle of trib-

ulation to glory was the universal belief of the truly born again members of the Church."

Dr. Oswald J. Smith said, "The new pre-tribulation rapture teaching was first proclaimed as a direct revelation by a woman in Edward Irving's church, and then taken up by John Nelson Darby (and the Scofield Reference Bible) in direct contradiction to the teaching of the Church for eighteen hundred years."

H.A. Baker said, "Beginning with the Irvingite woman, then propagated by John N. Darby about 1830, this new... doctrine... has come down to us until it has become popular. George Muller opposed it; so did Benjamin Wills Newton; so did Dr. S.P. Tregelles and other Brethren."

I blindly followed my denominational teaching by proclaiming that it would be first the rapture then, secondly, the appearance of the Anti-christ. But I discovered that the scripture really says, "Let no man deceive you by any means: for that day shall not come, except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition." (2 Thes. 2:3) The scriptures say plainly, **FIRSTLY** the Anti-christ... then **SECONDLY** the resurrection. The word "rapture" cannot be found in the Bible. Look it up and see! We have added that to our Christian vocabulary; God did not put it in His word.

CHURCH IS NOT READY YET

Jesus Christ is going to present a glorious church without spot, or wrinkle. (Eph. 5:27) It is obvious that the church is not ready for

His coming according to that standard. There is yet much perfecting of the church to do first, before Jesus comes.



It is a very grave error to promise Christians an escape instead of preparing them for the tribulation.

MORE BIBLE TRUTH

In studying II Thes. 2:7, Dr. Oswald J. Smith said, "He who now letteth will let, until he be taken out of the way." I learned from the Greek that the second 'he' is the Anti-christ, and that the Greek does not say... 'taken out of the way,' but 'revealed, in the midst.' In other words, lawlessness will be restrained until the appointed time for the lawless one, the Anti-christ to appear. There is no mention of the Holy Spirit at all. That is a Scofield Bible assumption. The Holy Spirit and the church remain to the end of the age."

SUPPER FOR SEVEN YEARS

Some people mistakenly teach that after the rapture we will all go to the marriage supper of the Lamb and will be there for seven years, eating and enjoying ourselves while God punishes the world. A close analysis of the scripture in I Thes. 4:17 shows that the word "meet" was only used in two other places, in scripture. In both places it means "returning with" and not "remaining at" the place of meeting. There is no scripture anywhere in the Bible that says we will remain for seven years in the air.

CAN THIS BE THE CHURCHES' DESTINY ?



I have been taught that the Greek word "parousia" always referred to the rapture and that other words were used for the coming of Christ in glory after the tribulation. But I found that this also is not true. "Parousia" is used for the coming in glory in II Thes. 2:1.

I BELIEVE IN THE RESURRECTION

I believe the spiritual bodies of the dead saints will be raised at the end of the tribulation & we who are alive will meet them. I Cor. 15:35-44. Since the resurrection occurs after the tribulation, then every born again believer in Jesus Christ needs to be awakened to this truth. They need to prepare and perfect themselves, through the word, by the Holy Spirit. Your hope of being taken out and away from the bad things may let you down and you may not have the power (Holy Spirit) to go through the trouble. Of all the people I know, not one person has ever found a single scripture that says we will be raptured before the tribulation. Have you?

Rev. 5:10 - ... hast made us unto our God kings and Priests: and we shall reign **ON THE EARTH.**
