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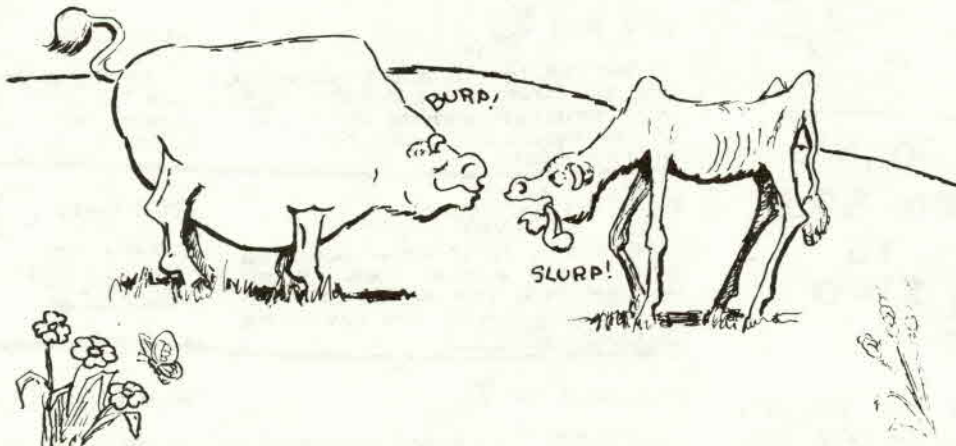
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FAT COWS and SKINNY COWS

(AND OTHER PERTINENT BIBLICAL SYMBOLS THAT HELP
UNLOCK THE MYSTERIES OF THE BOOK OF REVELATION.)



IN THE FIRST BOOK OF THE BIBLE WE FIND A KEY THAT UNLOCKS THE BOOK OF REVELATION. THE KEY IS THE DREAM OF PHARAOH AND IT'S INTERPRETATION GIVEN BY GOD THROUGH JOSEPH. YOU'LL RECALL PHARAOH DREAMED ABOUT SEVEN FAT COWS AND SEVEN SKINNY COWS - THE SKINNY ONES ATE THE FAT ONES. THEN HE DREAMED OF SEVEN FAT EARS (of grain) AND SEVEN SKINNY EARS - AGAIN THE SKINNY ONES ATE THE FAT ONES.

JOSEPH TOLD PHARAOH HIS TWO DREAMS WERE ONE. HE ALSO TOLD HIM THE COWS AND EARS STOOD FOR PERIODS OF TIME. YOU WILL SEE INSIDE THAT THIS INFORMATION IS A TREMENDOUS HELP TO ANYONE TRYING TO UNDERSTAND THE BOOK OF REVELATION. YOU'LL FIND THAT THE ONE BOOK IS ACTUALLY TWO BOOKS AND IN IT THERE ARE PARALLEL GROUPINGS OF SEVENS JUST AS WITH THE COWS AND CORN OF PHARAOH'S DREAM.

FAT COWS and SKINNY COWS

The book of Revelation has been a big question mark to most of Christianity ever since the day it was written. Can it be understood? We believe so. As you know it is full of symbols and

dark sayings.

Joseph's interpretation of Pharaoh's dream (the story is in Genesis 41:14-36) is the first account in the Bible of prophecy (the dream being a prophetic one) being interpreted. The method Joseph used forms a rule for the interpretation of all prophecy. The basic rule is that **GOD SPEAKS TWICE**. Job 33:14; Psalm 62:11; II Cor. 13:1; Matt. 18:16

GOD SPEAKS TWICE

One of the first things to notice in the interpretation is that Joseph told Pharaoh his two dreams were one. In like manner we now see that the book

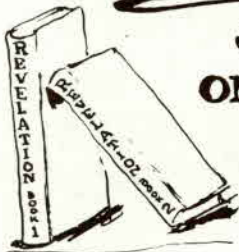
of Revelation is actually two books - two books telling the same story - just as Pharaoh's two dreams were really one, telling the same story.

We see that Pharaoh dreamed about fat cows and skinny cows, then he awoke, went back to sleep and dreamed about fat ears and skinny ears. Joseph told him that symbolically the cows and ear stood for the same thing - in this case periods of time. This will be important later when we find that in the book of Revelation seals are the same as angels and vials are the same as trumpets.

PHARAOH'S TWO DREAMS WERE ONE

If these are new thoughts to you, hang on, the parallels brought out in Revelation are amazing. They go beyond coincidence in proving that John was telling his story twice. This "revelation" will help you see the book of Revelation in an entirely new and exciting way. We believe it is being revealed now because God is shortly going to bring all things written in it to pass and he wants us to be prepared for all the good and bad stuff that's about to happen.

We said earlier that Joseph told Pharaoh the cows and ears were symbolically the same thing. Each fat cow and fat ear stood for a year of plenty. Each skinny cow and skinny ear stood for one year of famine. There were seven fat cows, seven skinny cows, seven fat ears and seven skinny ears - that's

PARALLEL TRUMPETS VIALS IN THE BOOK OF REVELATION

REV. 8:7



And the first angel sounded, and there were hail and fire mixed with blood and they were cast upon the EARTH: and the third part of the trees were burnt up, and all the green grass.

REV. 16:2



And the first went and poured out his vial upon the EARTH: and there fell a noisome and grievous sore upon the men which had the mark of the beast, and upon them which worshipped his image.

REV. 8:8



And the second angel sounded, and as it were a great mountain burning with fire was cast into the SEA: and the third part of the sea became BLOOD.

REV. 16:3



And the second angel poured out his vial upon the SEA: and it became as the BLOOD of a dead man: every living soul died in the sea.

And then the third angel sounded, and there fell a great star from heaven, burning as it were a lamp, and it fell upon a third part of the RIVERS AND FOUNTAINS OF WATERS.

And the third angel poured out his vial upon the RIVERS AND FOUNTAINS OF WATERS

REV. 8:12



And the fourth angel sounded, and the third part of the SUN was smitten, and the third part of the moon, and the third part of the stars.

REV. 16:8



And the fourth angel poured out his vial upon the SUN: and power was given unto him to scorch men with fire.

REV. 9:1



And the fifth angel sounded, and I saw a star fall from heaven unto the earth: and to him was given the key to the BOTTOMLESS PIT

REV. 16:10



And the fifth angel poured out his vial upon the SEAT OF THE BEAST:

REV. 9:13-14



And the sixth angel sounded, and I heard a voice from the four horns of the golden altar which is before God, saying to the sixth angel which had the trumpet, loose the four angels which are bound in the GREAT RIVER EUPHRATES.

REV. 16:12



AND THE sixth angel poured out his vial upon THE GREAT RIVER EUPHRATES.

REV. 10:7



But in the days of the voice of the seventh angel, when he shall begin to sound, the mystery of God should be FINISHED.

REV. 16:17



And the seventh angel poured out his vial into the air; and there came a great voice out of the temple of heaven, from the throne saying, It is DONE.

4 sets of seven.

IN GENESIS



Now notice in the book of Revelation we see a remarkable double or parallel. We see seven seals, seven trumpets, seven angel messengers and seven golden vials - 4 sets of seven. Revelation is doubled exactly like the first prophecy with interpretation in the Bible.

IN REVELATION



We take the words that are in the first interpretation in the book of Genesis and form a key from them. Then we take that key; insert it into the book of Revelation; twist it; and it works; the book is opened.

What we are saying up to this point is that the book of Revelation really has within it two books. The symbols in the books: the seals, trumpets, angel messengers and vials are not important in themselves but rather are used like the cows and ears of Pharaoh's dream to represent something else that is very important.

They tell the story of the gospel from the time of Christ until the end of this age and the beginning of a new one. Therefore some of the events recorded in them are now past and others yet to come.

The seals and trumpets are all a heavenly view, produced when Jesus Christ opens the seals on the book which is held in the hand of the One who sits on the throne (Rev. 5:7).

The angel messengers and the golden vials are an earthly view of the very same thing. They come forth from the book which John ate (Rev. 10:1). You will find the seals and trumpets described in Rev. 6:2-11:19. The angel messengers and the vials are described in Rev. 14:16-16:21.

To explain further what we mean by saying the seals are the same as the angel messengers and the trumpets are the same as the vials we will give you the following breakdown or comparison of the trumpets and vials. The parallels that exist between the trumpets and vials are easier to see and need less delving into than the seals

and the angels; for that reason we present them here.

As you can now plainly see John was telling his story twice. He is relating events that effect the earth, sea, rivers, etc. and except for the fifth and seventh trumpet and vial the same words are employed in the description of the places where the events occur.

I hope not, but you may by now be asking "so what?" If you have no familiarity with the book of Revelation this whole article may be a mass of confusion to you. But, if you are up on Revelation and familiar with the popular evangelical or fundamental interpretations of it you will see that what we are showing you clearly cuts through much of the confusion and wonder about the book. We are convinced the Bible interprets itself.

LIKE A GOOD MUG SHOT REVELATION GIVES US TWO VIEWS THAT BRING OUT DIFFERENT DETAILS.



Being able to separate the two stories John is telling and compare them is like being able to look at a good mug shot - it gives a front and side view of the same person, making it easier to identify them. John used this technique of doubles and parallels in all of his writing so it is not unusual to find it here. Besides, God has employed it from the beginning.
